Decorated BANNER Competition (parade)

| DESCRIPTION: | Show your Homecoming spirit by making and exhibiting a banner in the Homecoming parade. |

| DATE: | Saturday, February 12 at 10:00 AM (Line-up at 9:00 a.m.—Judging at 9:15 a.m.) |
| PLACE: | (Refer to Parade Route Map) The Homecoming parade will begin from the First Baptist Church of Morrow parking lot (lineup/staging area) and proceed down Jonesboro Rd (Rte. 54) through Morrow Station (Reviewing Stand and Tailgate Area) and disband on the Clayton State campus (Laker Hall Parking Lot) |
| PRIZES: | Monetary awards will be given to the top three Clayton State student organization/team banners: |
| | FIRST PLACE \$150 SECOND PLACE \$125 THIRD PLACE \$100 |
| | Selected by a panel of judges. |
| ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS: | Saturday, February 12, during the Homecoming Tailgate (approx. 12:00 p.m.). |
| COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS: | Banners will be judged based on the following criteria: |
| | Creativity Utilization of materials Clayton State Spirit |
| | Banners must contain the following: |
| | The organization's name (must spell out name). The phrase "Homecoming 2022" |
| | Banners should be 4' x 6'. Your organization must be able to carry the banner in the parade. |
| | Banners will be judged <u>before</u> the parade begins. <u>Arrive at</u> the parade staging area by 9:00 a.m. |
| PREPARATION AREA: | You may choose to use the designated parking area (near SAC) to work on your banner beginning at 5:00 p.m. the day before the parade. |
| NOTE: | Allocated Student Activities Funds may NOT be used to purchase supplies for banners. |

| DATE: | Saturday, February 12 at 10:00 AM (Line-up at 9:00 a.m.—Judging at 9:15 a.m.) |
| PLACE: | (Refer to Parade Route Map) The Homecoming parade will begin from the First Baptist Church of Morrow parking lot (lineup/staging area) and proceed down Jonesboro Rd (Rte. 54) through Morrow Station (Reviewing Stand and Tailgate Area) and disband on the Clayton State campus (Laker Hall Parking Lot) |
| PRIZES: | Monetary awards will be given to the top three Clayton State student organizations/teams decorated float/vehicle: |
| | FIRST PLACE \$500 SECOND PLACE \$350 THIRD PLACE \$200 |
| | Selected by a panel of judges. |
| ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS: | Saturday, February 12, during the Homecoming Tailgate (approx. 12:00 p.m.). |
| EVENT INFORMATION: | Decorated floats or cars will be judged based on the following criteria: |
| | Creativity Utilization of materials Clayton State Spirit |
| | Floats/cars must contain the following: |
| | The organization's name (must spell out name). The phrase "Homecoming 2022" |
| | Organizations must secure their own vehicles (i.e. flat-bed trailer, truck or automobile). Floats/cars will be judged before the parade begins. Arrive at the parade staging area by 9:00 a.m. |
| | Towing vehicles should be incorporated into the decorating scheme whenever possible. "Float" is used to define any mobile unit adequately decorated in the theme. |

Allocated Student Activities Funds may NOT be used to

purchase supplies for banners.

NOTE:

SAFETY:

For safety of riders, floats (especially those built on flatbeds) should have a safety handrail constructed around the perimeter of the float base and upright supports spaced throughout the unit to provide stability for anyone standing.

SEE ADDITIONAL PARADE REGULATIONS

FLOAT-BUILDING AREA:

You may choose to use the designated parking area (near SAC) to build and work on your float beginning at 5:00 p.m. the day before the parade. Floats and any tow-vehicles may remain in this area until the parade line-up time on Saturday.

While campus police will periodically patrol this area, the University cannot be responsible for safeguarding floats, materials, etc.

All floats and vehicles must be removed by 6:00 p.m. on Saturday. Float work areas must be cleaned up completely, and there should be no residual markings (paint, etc.) left on the road surfaces.
