Loch Shop: Examples of Costs of Buying Requested Number of Copies

Processing Costs = Freight in, freight out, estimated labor for processing in and out. \$11.00 per book (conservative estimate; some industry experts put this cost as high as \$15.00).

Carrying Costs = Here are represented in its simplest form, the actual cost of goods of the held inventory (I.e., it does not include Plant Overhead [i.e. our "Rent"], Labor Costs of Inventory Maintenance, or Opportunity Cost [Budgetary dollars tied up in inventory that cannot be invested elsewhere]).
