Policy for Admission of an Undergraduate Student to take a Graduate Course

An undergraduate student generally must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or higher and be within 30 semester hours of graduation.

Eligibility does <u>not</u> guarantee that a student will be admitted into a course. Admission must be approved by the course instructor, the Graduate Program Coordinator; the Dean of the School/College, and the Dean of the School of Graduate Studies. Students are reminded that a graduate course used to satisfy requirements for an undergraduate degree cannot be applied to a graduate degree at any later date.

One or more days may be needed to obtain the necessary materials in order to determine eligibility, as well as the approval signatures from the respective individuals.

Once eligibility is confirmed, students pursue the following process:

- 1. The student obtains appropriate signatures from the department/school in which the course is being offered.
- 2. Authorization from the appropriate area Graduate Program Coordinator
- 3. Signature from the Graduate Dean of the School of Graduate Studies (215 University Center 678-466-4113)

These signatures are obtained in the same order in which they are listed above.
