Major Description: The Music (B.A.) program at Clayton State allows the student to have a relatively high concentration in music courses (performance, ensembles, music history, and music theory) while taking a broad array of courses in or outside of music. This is a liberal arts degree and is not necessarily career-oriented. It is designed for students who want a broader overview of music and not an intense specialization in any one aspect of it.
