

Respondus LockDown Browser and Monitor – For Students

Respondus LockDown Browser and Monitor work to ensure secure testing.

Respondus LockDown Browser prevents you from navigating to other websites or opening other applications (Microsoft Word/OneNote, etc) while you are taking an exam.

Respondus Monitor requires you to have a webcam/microphone, show identification and show the area around your testing environment (known as an environmental scan) to ensure notes/books are not present. Respondus Monitor also records a video/audio feed during your exam session and will alert your instructor if excessive movement or noise is detected during the session. Your instructor can then review the video/audio to ensure you the integrity of the exam was maintained.

Downloading Respondus LockDown Browser

Step 1: Navigate to the D2L course using your regular web browser and locate the quiz. If LockDown Browser has already been installed you can click “Launch LockDown Browser”. Otherwise, you will be prompted to download and install the software.
