The College of Information and Mathematical Sciences at Clayton State University held their first annual Symposium "Innovations in Technology and Mathematics in March of 2022. The two-day event focuses on innovation in technology and mathematics and will feature presentations by guest lecturers, faculty, and current students, plus panels covering topics for both current students and alumni. The Symposium hosted nearly 350 students, faculty, alumni, and industry leaders. The Symposium helped create undergraduate scholarships for CSU students in STEM.

## Key Note Speakers:
