One-time FY16 Over 25K Funding Request

Description: Renovation of Counseling and Psychological Services (CAPS)

Amount Requested: \$45,000 (estimate for renovations + 5000 for reception area furniture)

Justification: CAPS requested a space modification in Fall of 2014, due to concerns regarding specific problems meeting the standards set forth by our accrediting body, the International Association of Counseling Services (IACS.) At the time of our re-accreditation visit in June 2015, the IACS site visitors indeed informed us that CAPS is in violation of accrediting standards due to the lack of an appropriate storage space for confidential materials, including files, records, and psychological assessments. IACS also noted that our student waiting area lacked in confidentiality due to its proximity to the Edgewater Hall hallway, and was also too small to accommodate the students seeking services at CAPS. In addition to allaying the concerns cited by IACS, the requested renovation will provide another counselor office. The original concern, also described in the Fall 2014 presentation to the Facilities Space Committee was that three individuals were sharing one office. The requested additional office will enable CAPS to function more effectively and allow usage of interns/practicum students/training site activities. CAPS and Facilities Management Staff have worked diligently to come up with some options for renovation that meet all of the needs described above.

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Description: Security Cameras for Clayton Station Phase 2 and cameras off core building for parking lot

Amount Requested: \$85,000

Justification: Clayton Station Phase 2 has long been without surveillance cameras due to the inability to run network infrastructure and purchase cameras with licenses. This purchase will significantly enhance our surveillance capabilities at Clayton Station Phase 2 and will thusly enhance student safety and security.
