Recommended expense categories in order of priority:

1. Practices to monitor and suppress COVID 19 (mandatory required use)
 - Implement evidence-based practices to monitor and suppress coronavirus in accordance with public health guidelines.
2. Outreach to Financial Aid Applicants (mandatory required use)
 - Conduct direct outreach to financial aid applicants about the opportunity to receive a financial aid adjustment due to the recent unemployment of a family member or independent student or other circumstances.
3. Recoup Lost revenue from state appropriation for FY22.
 - Priority use of these funds should go to investments in specific strategies to increase probability for student success such as academic support, tutoring, and selective use of on campus jobs in such areas.
4. Student debt discharge - balances outstanding from Spring 2020 onward
5. Recoup outstanding lost revenue from PPV projects (housing and SAC), auxiliary units (athletics, parking, etc.), departmental sales and service, student activity fees, and tech fee (in that order).
6. Minor remodeling
