4. Additional operating expenses—

Fee History

- No student fee increase since FY 2009
- Since 2009, the following changes have occurred that directly impact Parking Services budget:
- Addition of 800 more student residents at Clayton Station (now known as Clayton Village);
- 2. Construction of guard station and staffing;
- 3. Increased parking patrol areas to include both Clayton Village and CSU East; and Huie Hall; and
- Increased Public Safety needs with campus expansion, e.g. emergency phones, security cameras, increased lighting.

Revenue Enhancement Actions

- Increased parking fine structure in Fall 2015
- Issuance of four year parking permits began in Fall 2015
- Began assessing fees to faculty and staff for permits in Spring semester 2018.
- In Fall 2016, inclusion of some moving vehicle violations and municipal ordinance violations into campus administrative violations.

Although these actions should generate additional revenue for Parking Services, at best it will only offset some of the continuing reduction in student fee revenue.

- PURCHASE OF TRAMMELL PROPERTY FOR CLAYTON STATE UNIVERSITY: \$225,000 (2016)
- DUE DILIGENCE REPORTS FOR TRAMMELL PROPERTY PURCHASE: \$25,000 (2017)
- CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD BETWEEN MAIN CAMPUS AND CSU EAST: COST \$925,000
