- Current SAC Fee = \$100 per semester
- Fee began in Fall, 2007 and was \$75 until Fall,
 2013
- Proposed \$15 increase

Uses of SAC Fee

- Pay our debt service
- Student assistants for Fitness Center, Game Room, set-up for ballroom, building managers
- Two staff salaries
- Operations and maintenance of building
- Programming support for building/events
- Project proforma includes a state portion for partial operations and maintenance (utilities, supplies, and custodial salaries)

SAC Revenues for FY 2019

• Revenues: \$1,425,939

 Collected \$1,464,443 from SAC fee (students), and \$153,751 from ballroom rentals to external clients and from Fitness Center memberships to faculty/staff/community members
